**QUESTIONS YOU MAY HAVE...**

**Q. What does the ICYC do?**

**A. *The ICYC serves as a youth advisory board to the Ingham County Board of Commissioners. The ICYC makes sure that youth from the community have a voice in government policies relating to youth issues. This is done by educating both youth and adults in the community about the issues that are found by the ICYC to be important. Youth Commissioners also brainstorm and implement projects that will benefit the community.***

**Q. How many Youth Commissioners are there?**

**A. *Many counties in many states have Youth Commissions. They typically consist of between 10 and 20 Commissioners. The ICYC will house 15 members.***

**Q. When are the ICYC meetings and events?**

**A. *The ICYC will meet once per month. Because the ICYC is dedicated to empowering youth to create change, meetings and events are planned and facilitated by youth. After the initial meeting, dates and times will be specified by the youth.***

**Q. What is the time commitment of a Youth Commissioner?**

**A. *Besides monthly meetings, the ICYC will coordinate special projects in which each member should be involved. Youth will be responsible for serving up to a three-year term ending in August of each year, and are eligible for one re-election into the ICYC.***
