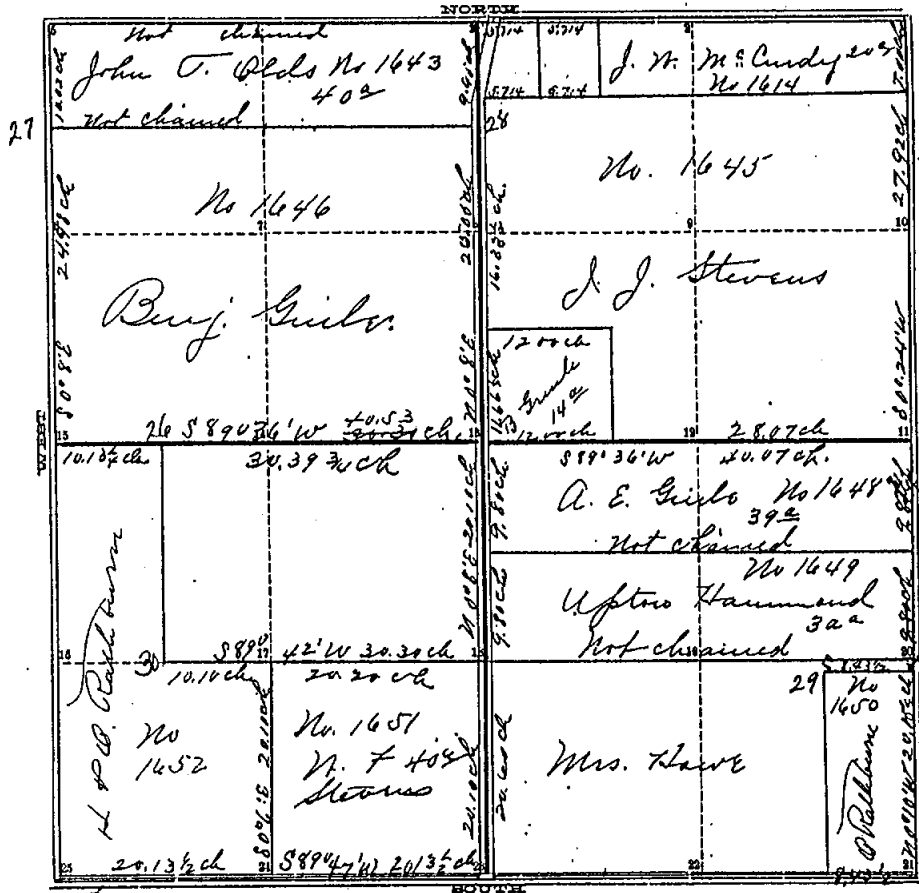

The small letters indicate corners established but not witnessed. The distance between (20) corners is two rods or fifty links the amount being taken of from the north half of the quarter section in the division of the Howe Estate.

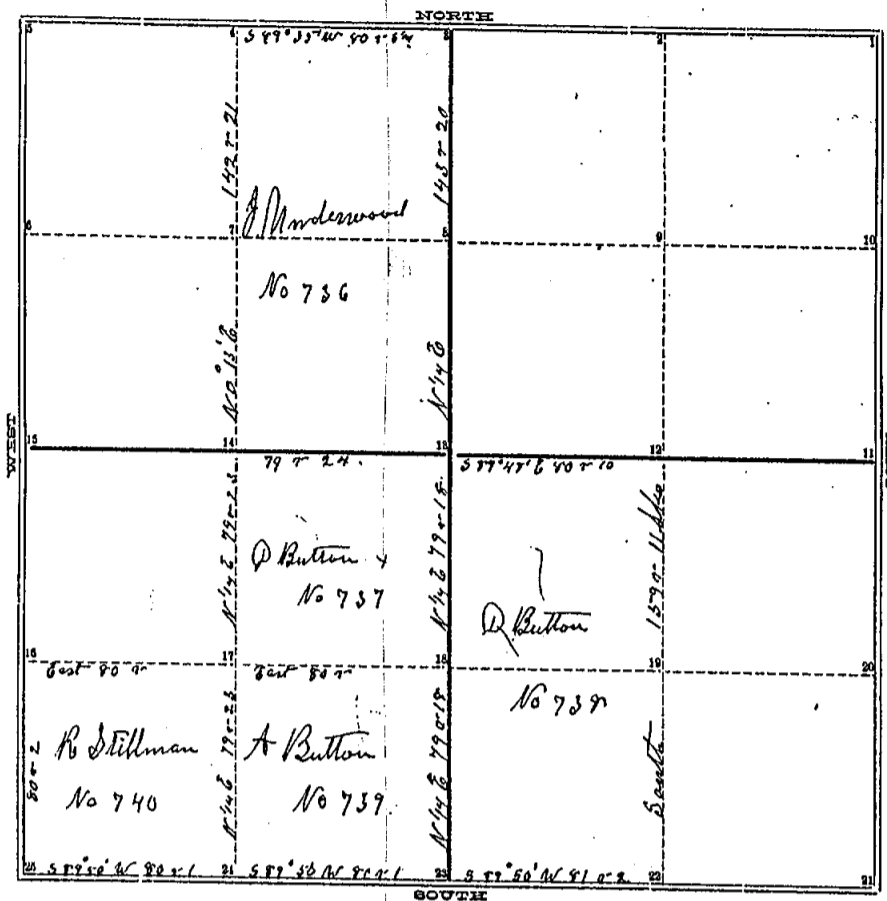

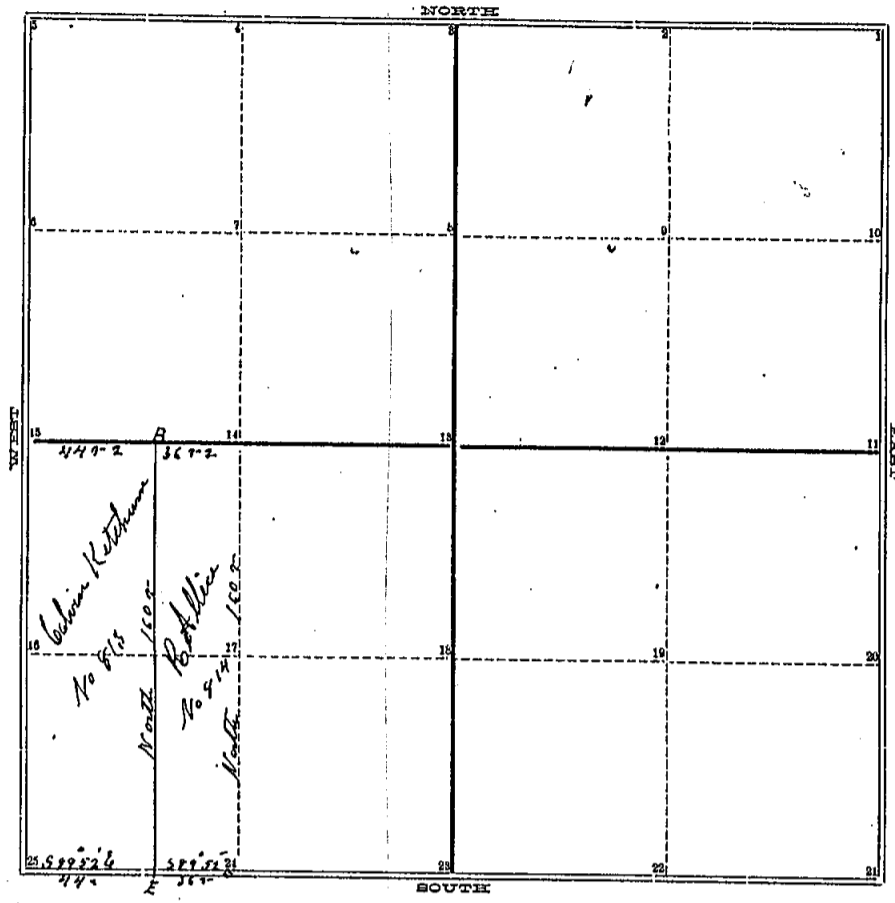

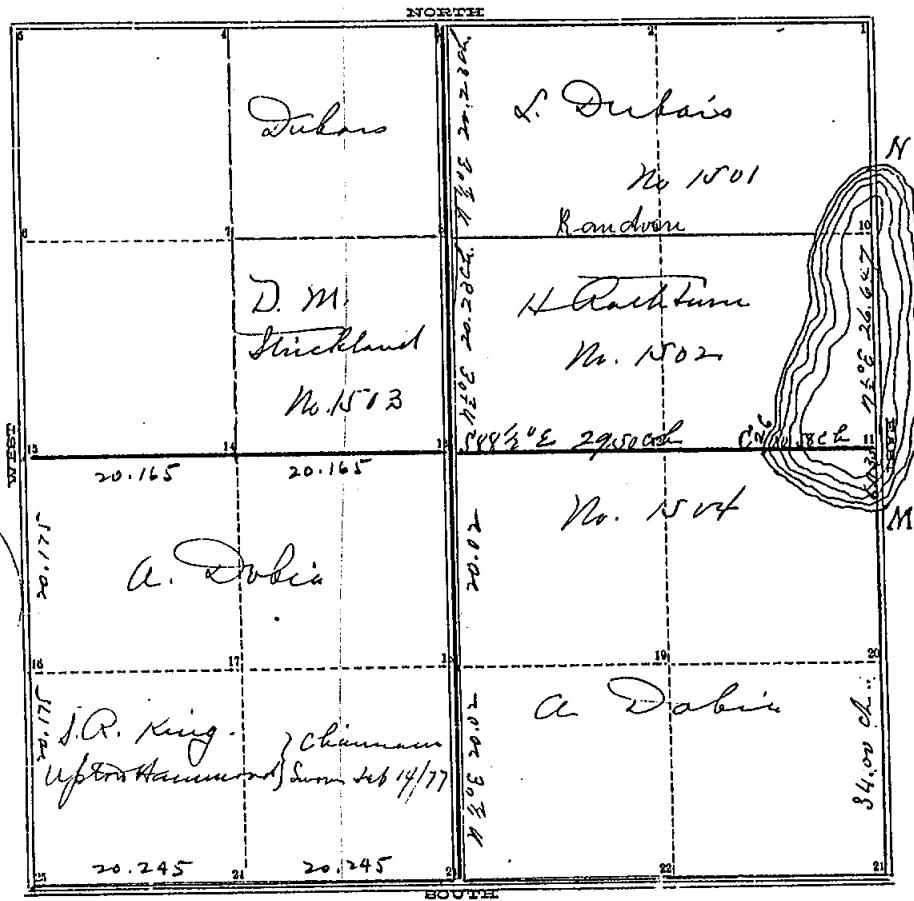

TOWN Three NORTH, RANGE 0 2^d West, MERIDIAN OF MICHIGAN.

Survey of the east and west quarter post line of section No Ten in Township No Three North of Range No One West; also the north half of the north and south quarter post line of same section, as represented by the accompanying plat (the scale of which is 12 chains to one inch); in which the bearings and distances of the lines surveyed, letters of reference to lines and corners, the position of the lake, roads &c are respectively given. Road lines being drawn with red ink.

The principal object of this survey was to find the east and west quarter post line. The corner at (11) being in the lake, and accessible only when the lake is frozen as in the present case. The N. S. bearings on the north & south shores of the lake are in good preservation, and their posts readily found, from which the point (11) was found. Also the corners (15), (3) & (23) were lost and reestablished in a right line between and equal distance from their respective section corners.

This point (11) was found as follows after chaining the line (21)-(27):
 $(21)(11) - (21)(23) = (27)(11)$, i.e. $40.00 - 34.00 = 6.00 = (28)(11)$ and
 $(21)(27) - (21)(28) = (27)(23)$, i.e. $66.00 - 34.00 = 32.00$ across lake by W. S. Surveying & Surv 3268
 which give a difference of 18 link there from
 $(21)(11) = 6.00 \times 18 \div 32.00 + 42.00 = 40.033$ and their signals at (15) & (11) both seen from an intermediate point in right line between determined the location of said line.
