

2010 Horse Camp Camping Rules

We are excited to be able to offer camping at horse camp this year.

Camping will be \$25.00 a night with a valid reservation.

We will have 25 available on a first reservations received policy. You must have a confirmation from Kara Slater-Fleminger to have a valid reservation. We have reserved 10 of them for out of county 4H'ers. Any open spots still available will be available first come first serve the day of haul in. Please call Kara Slater-Fleminger @ 517-525-5984 for reservations and availability. Please read and sign. Failure to follow rules will result in, and up to and including being asked to leave camp.

1. Parents or a family member must camp with the campers.
2. No children may be left unattended at night.
3. All horses must be in stalls and lights out by 11pm.

Your horses have been worked hard and need their rest.

4. No beer or alcoholic beverages allowed on the fairgrounds
5. Cars/trucks must be out of the camping area by 7am.

Two vehicles in each camp site

6. No empty horse trailers in camping area.

Please park them across the road to the east.

7. You may bring in your campers after 12 noon on Monday June 14th.
8. No horses in camping area
9. Dogs must be on a leash at all times and have proof of shots. Please don't bring aggressive dogs. Loud, obnoxious dogs will be asked to leave the grounds.
10. No bikes

Additional power cords will be charged an extra 25.00. only one plug in allowed per electrical box
