Please fill out the following information for camping at South End Fair. Due to the increase in camping requests, Horse Committee needs the following information for camping assignments.

**Camping Rules:**

1. No parking of vehicles will be allowed in the camping area starting 8:00 a.m. until showing is finished for the day. Then only ONE vehicle per campsite.
2. Camper must visibly display camping pass.
3. No dogs allowed on the Fairgrounds. The exception being Leader Dogs, Show Dogs and K-9 Dogs. *(This rule will be strictly enforced.)* No generators allowed.
4. No alcoholic beverages to be consumed on grounds or in buildings.
5. No youth under 14 will be allowed to stay in barn, trucks, trailers, campers or tents unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
6. No bicycles, golf carts/ATV/Recreational Vehicles allowed on the grounds for use by Exhibitors. Special consideration for disabled needs can be requested at the fair office. No motorized scooters, skateboards or in-line skates allowed on the grounds. No campfires allowed. **Fire lanes around the campsites must be clear at all times.**
