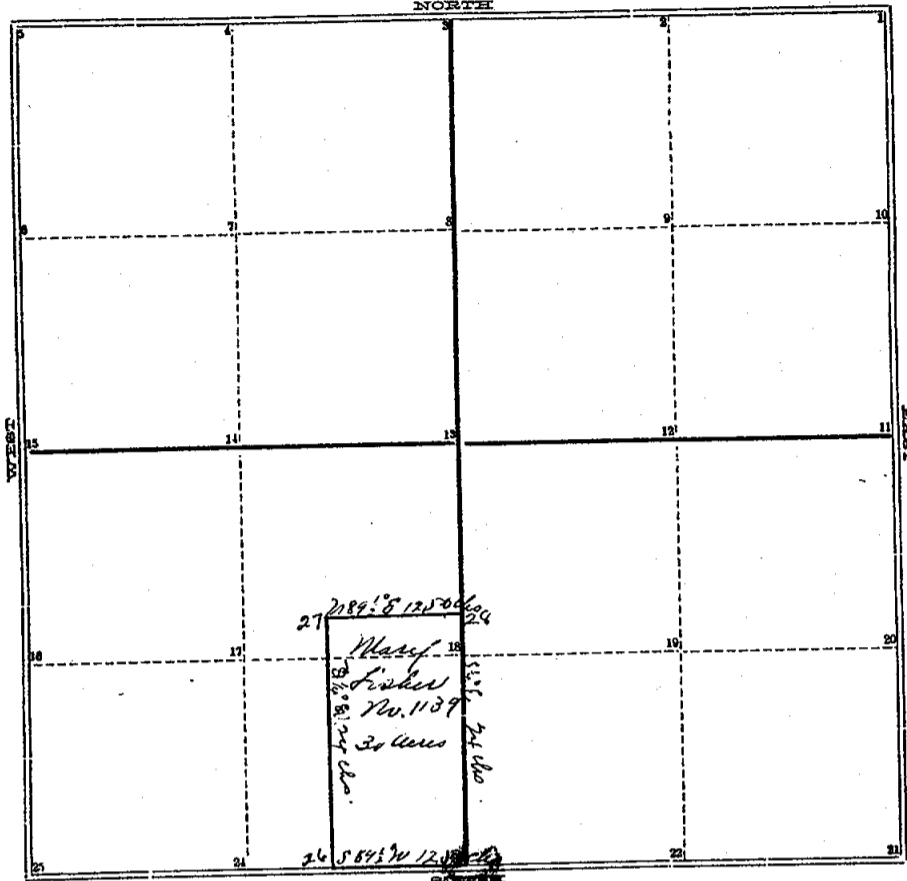

TOWN Carleton NORTH, RANGE Town West, MERIDIAN OF MICHIGAN.

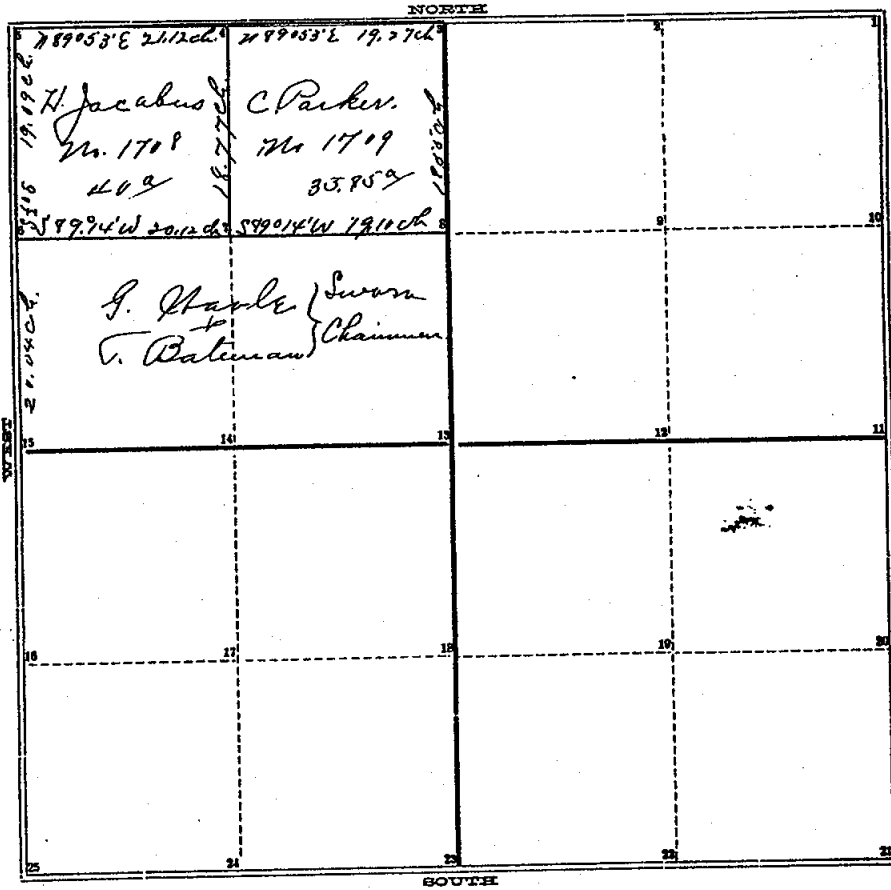
Survey of 30 acres in the s.e. corner of the s.w. quarter of section 1 T. 12 N. of R. 2 W. Commencing at the south quarter corner of section 1 represented by "23" in the plat from which a Sugar 6 inches <sup>in diameter</sup> bears S 75 1/2° E 184 links and a B Cherry 6 inches N 79° W, 213 links; running thence S 89 1/2° W 12.50 chains to "26" on the south side of said section from which the s.w. corner of house bears N 35° E 108 links and a B Cherry bears S 86 1/2° W; thence N 1/2° W 24 chains to "27", from which a Swamp 20 inches bears S 76° E, 87 links and Elm 24 inches bears S. 5 1/2° W, 138 links; thence N 89 1/2° E 12.50 chains to "28" from which a B. Wood 20 inches bears S 49° W, 93 links and Beech N 49° E 29 links (These witnesses have no links) thence on quarter line S 1/2° E 24 chains to "23" place of beginning. Containing thirty acres of land. Run by the True Meridian Magnetic Variation 2 3/4° E Surveyed & recorded by J. M. H. Rayner, A. Surveyor Gen. of Mich. Mar. 18<sup>th</sup> 1863.

INGHAM COUNTY, MICHIGAN.

TOWN Two NORTH, RANGE Two West, MERIDIAN OF MICHIGAN.

Born by the True Meridian  $N 03^{\circ} E$   
Surveyed and Recorded Dec 7. 1847  
by A. Jackson Co Surveyor

On Apr. 16 1912 I surveyed the S. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 12  
T 7 N R 7 W. for L. C. Baird & J. W. Eames.  
Found the S.E. corner of Sec. 12 Iron & stone  
Chained north on top line. Dug for the  $8\frac{1}{4}$  foot post  
could find nothing as located it from adjacent corners  
and set Blue stone 2' long J. W.  
S. Maple S-W 60 lbs. B. Oak S-W 79 lbs.  
Found center of Sec. 12 and located No 17  
Chained from S.E. Cor to  $5\frac{1}{4}$  foot and located No 22  
Chained from  $5\frac{1}{4}$  post to center post and located No 18.  
The ran line from No 12 to No 22 and from No 18 to  
No 20 and located No 19.
