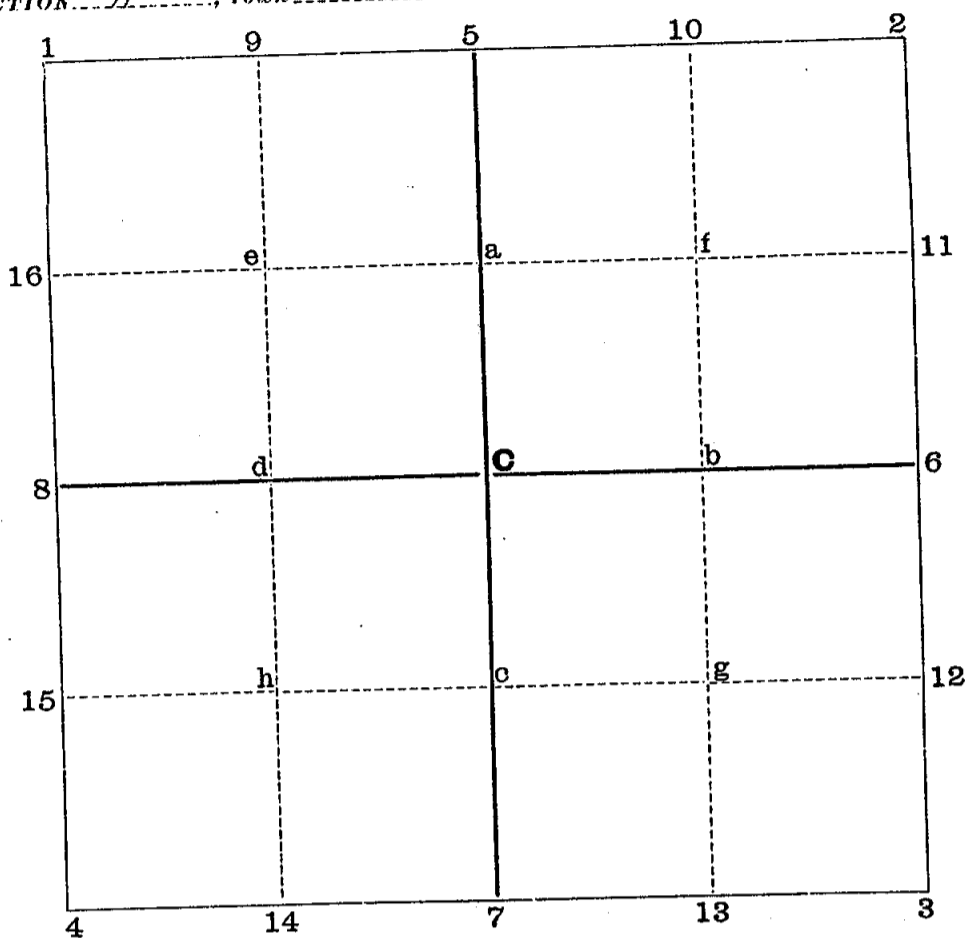

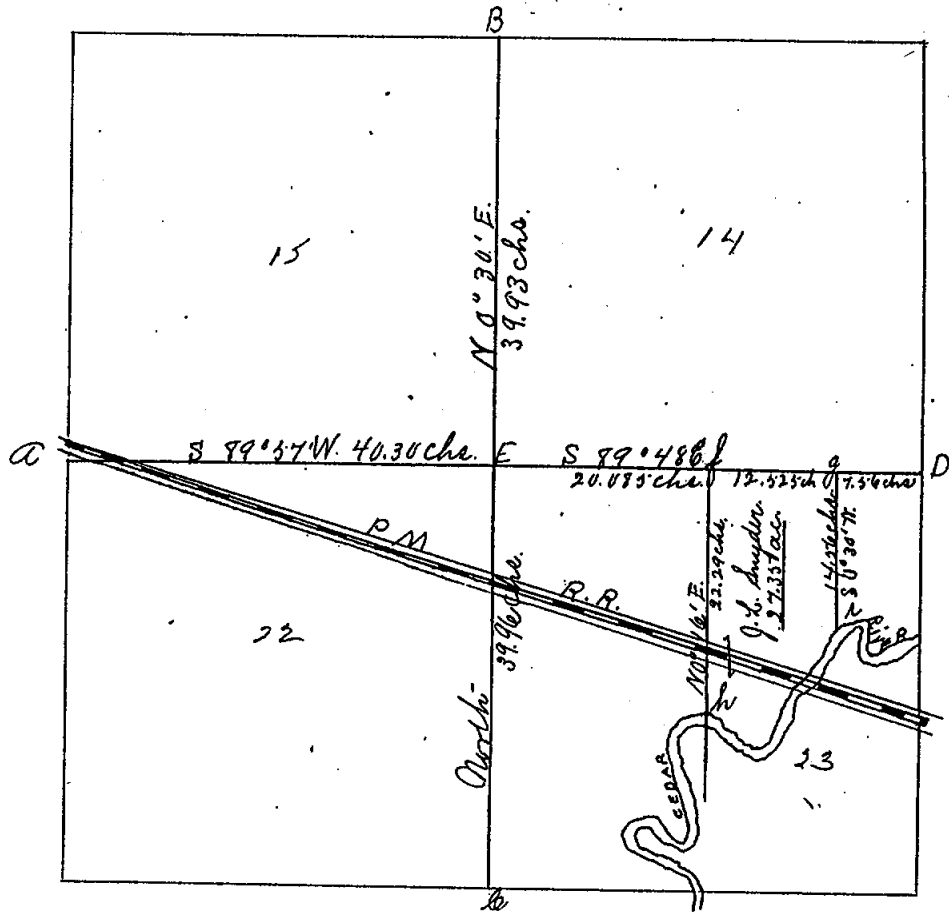

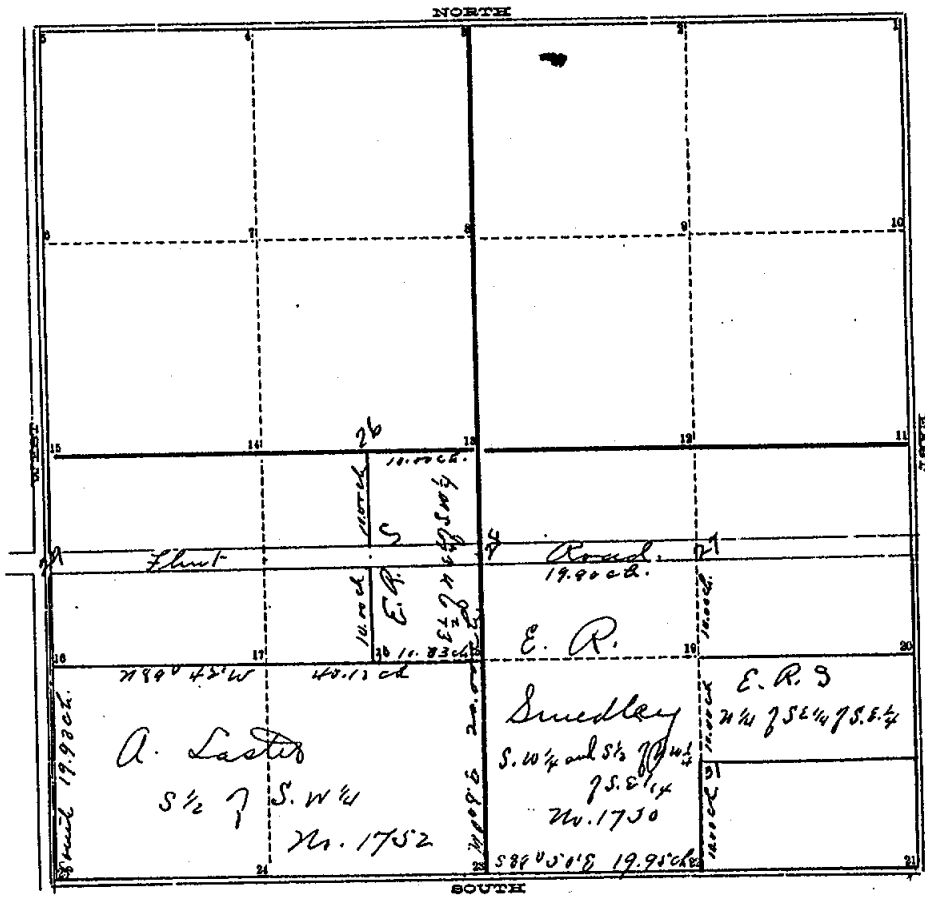

Survey of the south half of Section No Two in Township No Four North of Range No Two West as shown by the plat, being divided as there in represented. This section was quartered by T. J. Brown Nov. 19th 1874 (See page 115) at which time the center (3) was established. The corners (15), (11), (21) (23) & (25) were found from the original survey. The application for this survey was made by E. R. Smedley

Abner Lister, Wm. Thompson and Edward D. Allen were duly sworn as chainmen.
