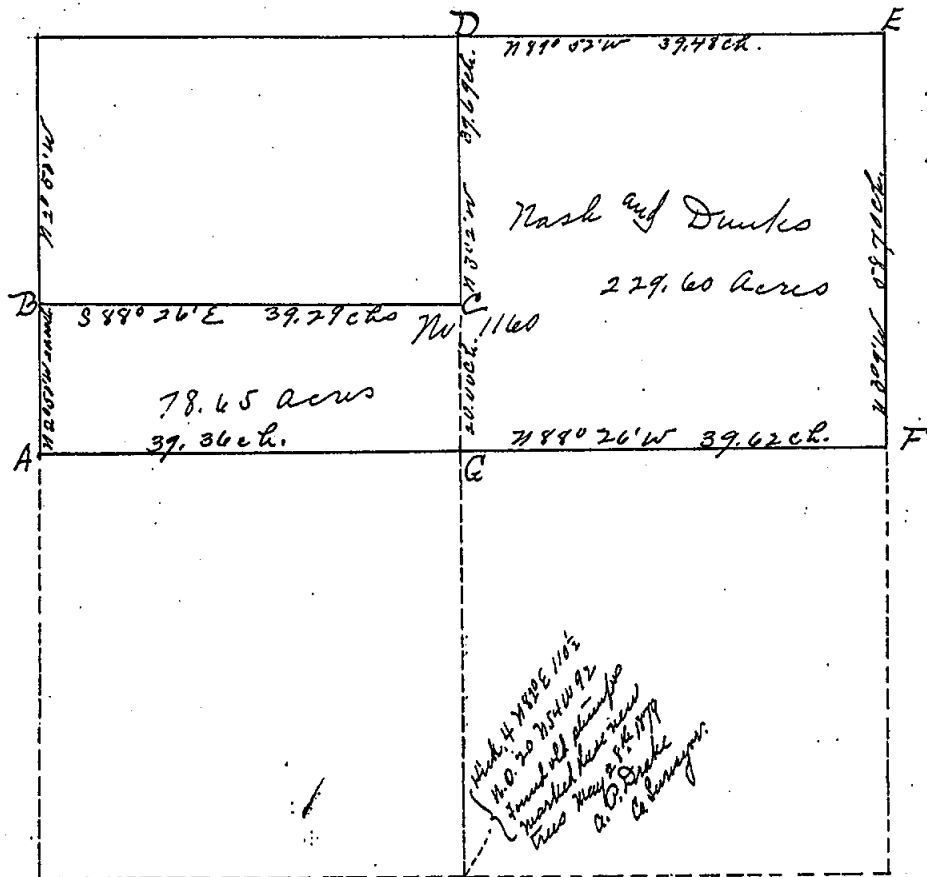

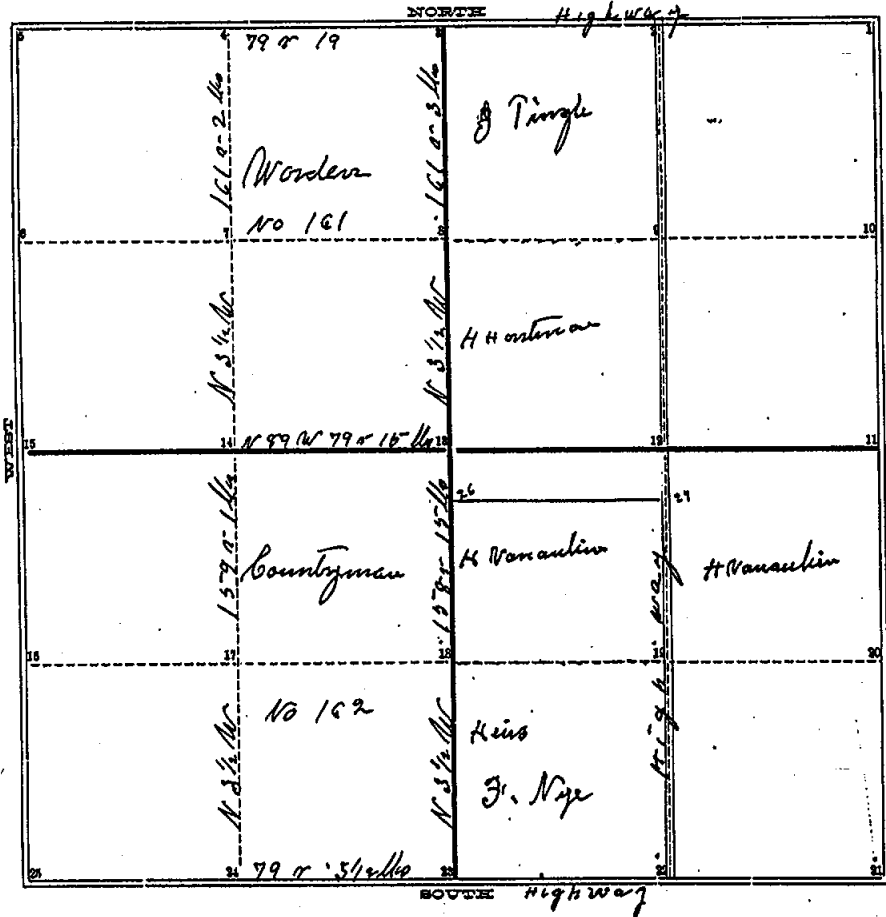
Survey of the north half of section Five (T4 N. R. 2 E. Beginning at the quarter post in the west line of said section represented in the accompanying plat by (A) from which a Swamp White Oak Double 24 inches diameter bears S $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E & Ironwood 10 inches bears $71^{\circ}54'$ E 31 links. Running thence $71^{\circ}50' W$ on the said west line of the section 20.00 chs. to a post (B) in marsh from which post a Yellow Oak 10 in. diam. bears S $88\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 364 links; thence S $89^{\circ}26'$ E 37.29 chs. to a post (C) in the north & south quarter post line of said sec. (C) in marsh (No witness trees) Thence $71^{\circ}02' W$ on said quarter post line 37.69 chains to the quarter post (D) in the north line of said section from which post a White Oak 18 inches in diameter bears S $1^{\circ}10'$ E 271 links (No other tree). Thence S $89^{\circ}52'$ E on the said north line of the section 39.48 chains to (E) the north east corner of the section from which corner (E) a low Tamarac stump say 10 in diameter bears S 90° E 187 links (This in marsh). Thence S $80^{\circ}9'$ E on the east line of said section (S) 58.70 chains to the quarter post (F) on the East line of said section from which post (F) and Elm 16 inched diameter bears S 17° E 83 links & Black Oak 12 inched diam. bears S $8^{\circ} W$ 93 links, thence $78^{\circ}26' W$ on the East and west quarter post line 78.98 chains to the place of beginning. Containing 308.25 acres as expressed in the plat

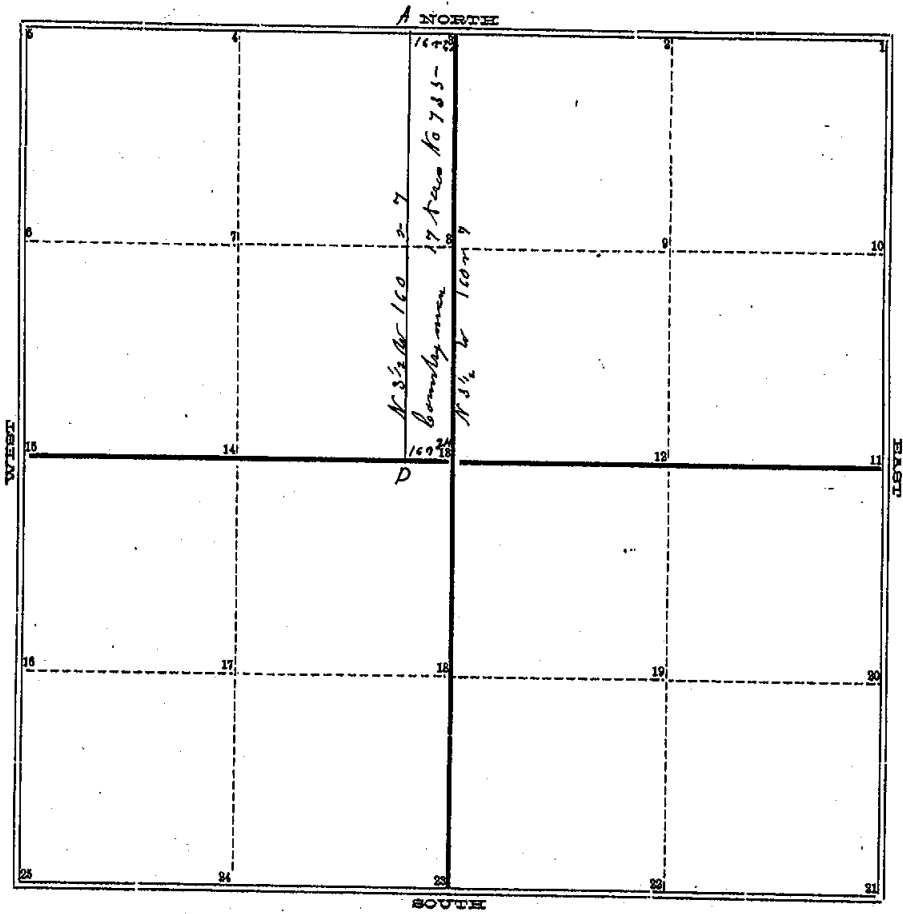
