TOWN One NORTH, RANGE Two West, MERIDIAN OF MICHIGAN.

Survey of the Northeast quarter of section No Thirteen in Township No One North of Range No Two West as represented by the accompanying plat of the scale of which is Thirteen chains to one inch by which the bearings and length of the lines surveyed, the position of the roads, the names of the owners, the number of acres owned by each, and letters of reference to lines and corners are respectively given.

Note: - The corner (11) was lost but the corresponding corner in T1N R1W established by Mr. Jackson was readily found and this corner was located at its proper distance south of it being nine links there from.
