TOWN Three NORTH, RANGE One East, MERIDIAN OF MICHIGAN.

Survey of the east half of the north east quarter of the north east quarter of section 17 Town 3. N. R. 1. E. Beginning at the north east corner of said section at a post "1" from which a swamp white Oak 22 inches diameter bears $N 76^{\circ} E$ 184 $\frac{3}{4}$ links and a Sugar 3 inches diameter bears $N 84^{\circ} W$ 214 $\frac{1}{2}$ links; running thence $S 2^{\circ} 25' E$ 19.89 chains on the east line of said section to a post "10" at the division joint from which a Beech 12 inches diameter bears $N 72^{\circ} E$, 56 $\frac{2}{3}$ links; thence East $S 89^{\circ} 40' W$ on said division line 9.985 chains to a post "26" from which a Black Oak 22 inches diameter bears $N 11^{\circ} W$, 55 links and an Elm 22 inches diameter bears $S 37^{\circ} W$, 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ links; thence $N 2^{\circ} 25' W$ on the line of equal divisions 19.89 chains to a post "27" in the north line of the section from which a Butte nut 6 inches diameter bears $N 57^{\circ} W$, 98 links; thence $N 89^{\circ} 40' E$ on the said north line of the section 9.985 chains to the place of beginning containing 19.86⁸ acres Run by the True Meridian Variation $27^{\circ} E$

Survey of section Twenty nine in Township No Three North of Range No One East as shown by the plat the scale of which is 13 chains to one inch by which all the corners are described by letters referring to the same, and the distance given on all lines measured. The east half of the south west quarter was divided thus 22.66 acres being set off from the north end, then 22.68 acres from the west side of what remained leaving 24.66 acres more or less in 1883 in compliance with the deeds here of

Note: At the corner (1) I find ~~to~~ stakes ~~one~~ made by W. H. Rayner, the other claimed by Mr. Kent to be the original corner and I am of the opinion that he is right and my reasons are that that the original survey makes the west half of section Twenty nine 40.08 chains and the east half of section 29, 40.03 chains or difference of 5 links. Now according to Mr. Rayner the west half of section 28 16 links too long and the east half of section 29, 16 links too small. When the corner noted in this record makes the sides agree with the original
