

The Stanley S. Levandowski, Sr. Memorial Zoo Mural - A Call for Entries A Community Art Project Sponsored by L&L Food Centers



Children and adults, under the direction of professional mural artist, Tony Hendrick, will produce a Memorial Zoo Mural that will be installed at the Farmyard Edventure at Potter Park Zoo. The Memorial Zoo Mural is a tribute to L&L Food Center's founder, Stanley S. Levandowski, a man who loved children and celebrated family by actively supporting and promoting "L&L Zoo Days".

Design guidelines:

- Artists of all ages and abilities are invited to submit designs for the Memorial Zoo Mural.
- The Mural project is a collection of 10 different visions celebrating the relationship between people and agricultural animals from around the world. The goal of the artwork is to provide visual confirmation of the tremendous contributions agricultural animals have made to the human family: food and dairy, textiles, power supply, transportation, and pets.
- The final size of each mural section will be 4' H x 8' W. All designs entries should match these proportions and must be horizontal.
- Give your image visual OOMPH so that it can be appreciated from a distance, while also giving the viewer something to discover up close.
- Inspire us! Draw something that truly inspires YOU and it will very likely make a connection with others, too.

All completed designs must have all contact information filled out completely and may be returned by mail to L&L Corporate Offices or dropped off at any L&L Food Center. The extended deadline for all submissions is **December 18, 2009**.

Ten winning designs will be selected, and winners will be in January.

Six (6) mural workshops to execute the winning designs will be held at Potter Park Zoo in January and February and artists of all ages and abilities are invited to attend any one of them. Supplies and refreshments will be provided. The workshops are a great opportunity to practice communication and group skills while learning mural painting. Tony will lead each group in the creative process, and diversity of talent from novice to advanced will be the strength of the group! The only requirement for participation is the willingness to have fun, be mindfully present, and create with others!
